STARTS: Tuesday, September 24, 2024 TIME: 4:00PM – 7:00 P.M. DURATION: 10 WEEKS

This league uses NRA 50ft Slow and Timed (B-2)/Rapid Fire (B-3) targets. A perfect score for a target set is 600 points.

<u>COURSE OF FIRE:</u> Mandatory reloads; Stages 1 & 2 reload at will; Stages 3 - 6 reload on RO command.

Alibi: One (1) per target on stages three through six. No alibis allowed on stages one and two.

REGISTRATION AND FEES:

Registration: \$5.00 Target set fee (Per Week): \$15.00

FIREARMS:

Any .22 LR rimfire, single or double action revolver or semi-automatic pistol. Iron, optical, or electronic sights allowed. No target painting lasers.

FIRING:

Pistols may be cocked for first shot. All starts are from the raised position.

SCORING:

Competitors will score their own targets at the end of each week's course of fire. Write name, stage, date, and target number at top right of each target. Targets will be collected and reviewed by league officials. Target sets returned the following week.

PENALTIES:

False start / Late shots: Competitors shooting before/after the sounding of the stage whistle will lose as many high scoring shots as were fired before/after the stage whistle.

Extra shots: Competitors with a higher hole count on a target than allowed in a stage will lose as many high scoring shots as needed to reduce the hole count to that allowed in the stage.

BANQUET AND AWARDS:

A banquet will be held after the completion of the league to hand out prizes and individual awards. See website for banquet details. Awards are for individual performance and based on Lewis Class system. Number of classes based on number of participants, three places each class. A most X's notation (or trophy) and a most improved trophy will also be awarded. All prizes distributed by random drawing. Participants must have paid all league fees and have turned in ten target sets by week ten of the league to be eligible for prizes and awards. Except for grand prize, participants must be present to win.
