League Shoots on: Thursdays @ 6:00 - 7:30PM

This league meets on Thursday evenings. Couples form a team and due to the difference in stage timing, there is a men's course and women's course. Team ranking determined by individual, handicapped scores. Multiple target sets may be shot on league nights allowing shooters to either catch up on missed weeks or to shoot ahead. This league uses half-size silhouette targets. A perfect score for a target set is 420 points.

Alibi: Men: One (1) per course but may not be used in 6th stage.

- Women: One (1) per stage but may not be used in 6th stage.
- Proxy: A team may shoot one additional target set per individual during the 10-week league to replace their worst scoring target set.

INDIVIDUAL REGISTRATION AND FEES: Registration: \$5.00 Course (Nightly): \$15.00

FIREARMS: A speed-loader or two magazines required. May use iron, optical or holographic/dot electronic sights. No target painting lasers allowed.

Men: Any modern centerfire revolver or semi-automatic pistol; six-shot minimum. .45 Cal Max. **Women**: Any modern center or rimfire revolver or semi-automatic pistol; six-shot minimum. .45 Cal Max.

FIRING:

Shooters should start from the safest action possible (either slide back or hammer down, or safety on). Men start from the bench; women may start from the raised position.

SCORING:

Competitors score their own targets at the end of each week's course of fire. Write name, stage, date, and target number on top right of each target. Target set will be collected and reviewed by league officials, then returned the following week.

PENALTIES:

False start / Late shots: Competitors shooting before/after the sounding of the stage whistle will lose as many high scoring shots as were fired before/after the stage whistle.

Extra shots: Competitors with a target hole count greater than 6 (or 12) will lose as many high scoring shots as needed to reduce the hole count to 6 (or 12).

BANQUET AND AWARDS: A banquet will be held after the completion of the league to hand out prizes and individual awards. Awards are based on Lewis Class system. Number of classes based on number of participants, three places each class. A most X's notation (or trophy) and a most improved trophy will also be awarded. All prizes distributed by random drawing. Participants must have paid all league fees and have turned in ten target sets by week ten of the league to be eligible for prizes and awards. Except for grand prize, participants must be present to win.
